

DECCA 2+2 RECORD BRUSH

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE:

- 1. Hold the brush on the rotating disc for a number of revolutions - the cleaner the record the fewer the revolutions required. NO pressure is necessary, the weight of the brush is calculated to give the most efficient cleaning power.**
- 2. Dust collected on the brush may be removed by gently drawing the brush across the two ridges located on the underside of the stand.**
- 3. Neglected records will benefit from the use of the shorter set of brushes inside the 2 + 2. Use as follows:-**
 - (a) Place the brush on its stand.**
 - (b) Whilst holding the stand firmly, slide the metal cover of the brush in the direction indicated by the arrow printed on top. (under Patents Pending Made in England)**
 - (c) Remove brush unit from stand, invert brush unit, replace on stand and slide metal cover into place.**
- 4. Always keep the brush on its stand when not in use.**
- 5. No antistatic liquid is necessary with the Decca 2 + 2 Record Brush. Should the brush become matted with liquids previously used or by chemical migrating from the record or record sleeves, it can be restored to its original condition by the following method:-**

Wash the brush in a 50/50 mixture of alcohol and water with a drop of detergent added. When the brush is clean it can be dried with the warm flow of air from a hair dryer - always maintaining a minimum distance of 12" from the hair dryer nozzle to the brush as excessive heat may cause damage.
